### Improving your wastewater network – Northern Interceptor wastewater pipe construction Greenhithe Road

We would like to bring you up to date with our construction works in the location of Greenhithe Road. Our contractor, The Fletcher Construction Company, will commence construction of the pipeline in late June and will progress down Greenhithe Road at approximately 30m per week. We expect the works to be completed past Collins Park by the end of September 2019.

Once the works on Traffic Road have been completed, we will cross over Tauhinu Road and proceed into Greenhithe Road. The trench alignment will be on the right hand side of the road as indicated in the graphic below.



#### How will it affect you?

- A one way traffic system will be in set-up. Temporary traffic lights will be installed at night and stop/go traffic management will be in operation during the day. Traffic management personnel will be onsite during the works. They will assist you should you have any access issues with access to your property/business. Please advise if you have any specific issues that need to be taken into account.
- A no parking area will be imposed adjacent to the working area.
- We will endeavour to keep your driveway access open during the works. Should restrictions be required, we will work with residents as far as practicable to address any concerns. At times access to driveways will be restricted over night, but temporary parking will be made available to you during this time.
- If you do not typically park on the road overnight but will do so during construction, we advise that you inform your insurance company as a precaution.
- Working hours will typically be from 7.00am to 6.00pm on Monday to Friday, and from 8.00am to 5.00pm on Saturdays. Where works are required outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.
- Increased truck movements during construction hours.
- On rubbish day please leave your bins on the berm and we will move them for the rubbish truck to collect. Please make sure they are clearly numbered so we can bring them back.
